# PARTNERSHIP FOR SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES

- Interagency Partnership for Sustainable Communities established in June 2009
- Six Livability Principles act as a foundation for the interagency coordination
- Three agencies link their resources, policies and efforts throughout the country

# MAP-21 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES (TA) PROGRAM

- Provides for a variety of alternative transportation projects that were previously eligible activities under separately funded programs
- New definition incorporates many transportation enhancement activities and several new activities
- Recreational Trails Program remains unchanged and is an eligible activity
- Safe Routes to School Program is an eligible activity

# LIVABILITY PROJECTS & MAP-21 FORMULA PROGRAMS

## Transportation Alternatives:

- Transportation Enhancements (TE)
- Recreational Trails
- Safe Routes to School (SRTS)

## Part of New Core Formula Program Structure:

- Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ)

## Current Discretionary Program:

- Projects of National and Regional Significance (PNRS) (TIGER-like)
