Resort Fee

There will be a \$25 resort fee, per room, per day which includes free Wi-Fi throughout the hotel and 20% off Spa and Salon services.

Parking

Valet is \$24 per day.

Cancellation Policy

Reservations cancelled on or before 15 days prior to arrival shall not be assessed any cancellation penalty. **Reservations cancelled inside of 15 days prior to arrival shall be charged in full for the individual reservation.** Guests not arriving for a scheduled reservation will be billed for their entire reservation.

Wireless Internet

Wi-Fi will be available in your guest room as well as throughout the hotel including all meeting spaces. Upon check-in, you will receive a password to log into the network.

- Grand Junction Regional Airport (GJT) - 2 1/2 hours to Mountain Village
- Durango-La Plata Regional Airport (DRO) - 2 1/2 hours to Mountain Village

Time Zone

Telluride, CO is located in the Mountain Daylight Time Zone (GMT-6).

August average high temperature: 65.1°F (18.4°C) / average low is 41.7°F (5.4°C).

Getting Around Mountain Village and Telluride

Transportation/Gondola

The Gondola shuttles commuters up and over 10,500-foot Coonskin Ridge. The ride on the "G" provides expansive vistas of the San Juan Mountains, Aspen-cloaked mesas and sun-struck waterfalls as well as a bird's eye view of both towns. On a clear day, riders can see all the way to the La Sal Range in Utah.



The gondola is free, handicap accessible, and pet-friendly.

7 a.m. – midnight (with extended hours until 2 a.m. on Friday and Saturday night)

The Peaks Resort is in Mountain Village, just a quick gondola ride to Telluride. The ride is approximately 13 minutes in length, and eliminates the 20 minute, 8-mile drive between Telluride and Mountain Village.
