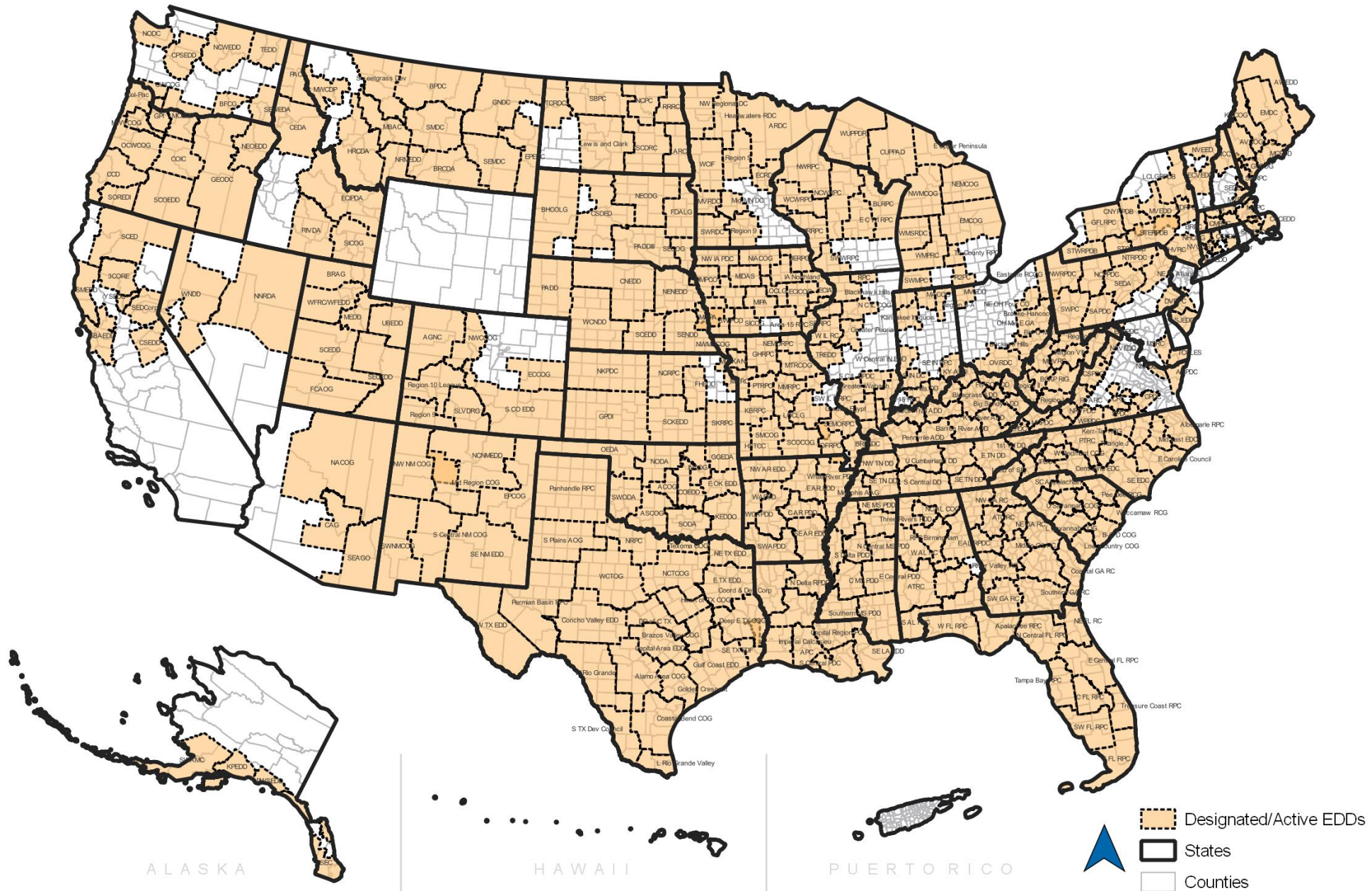

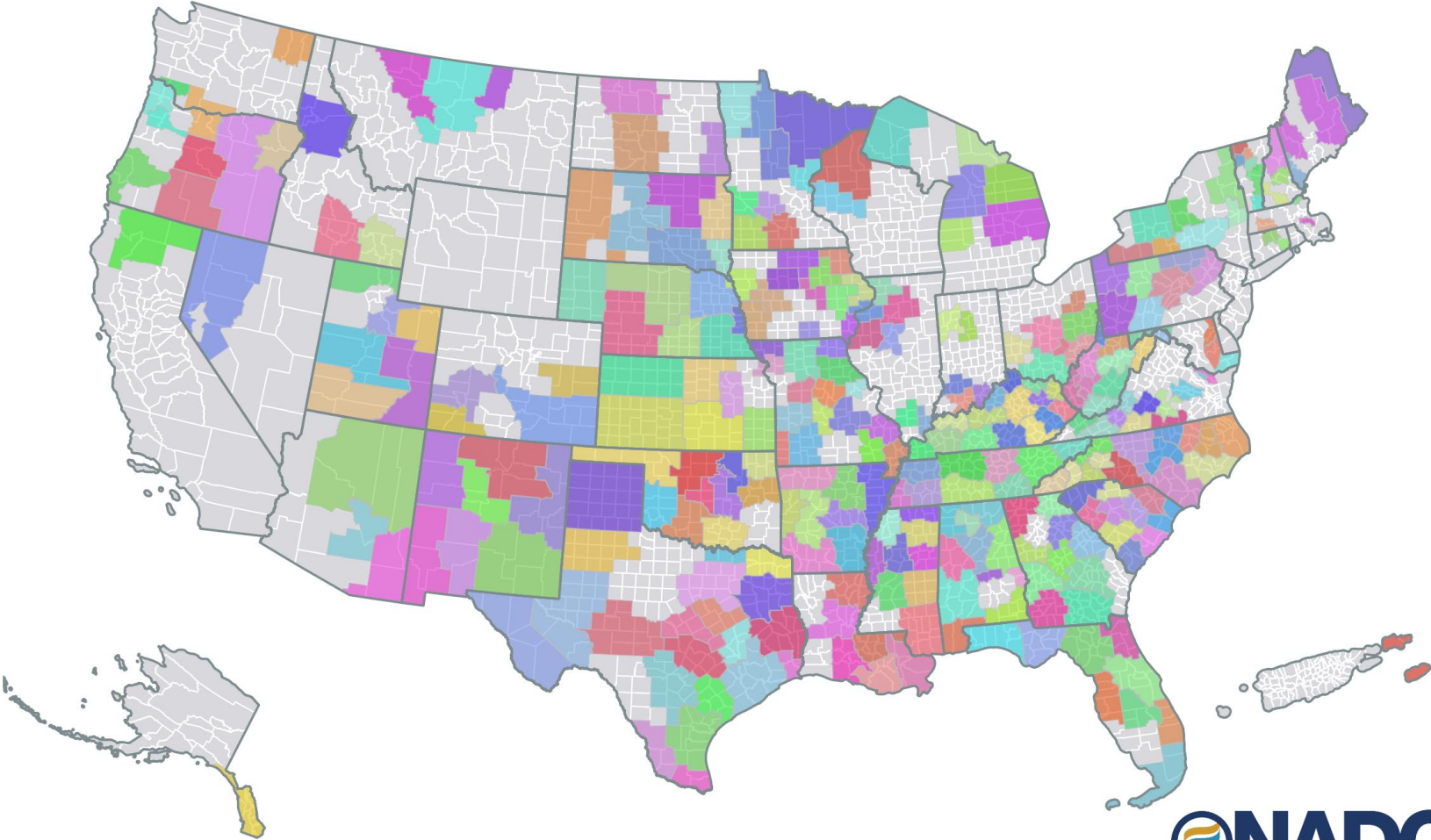

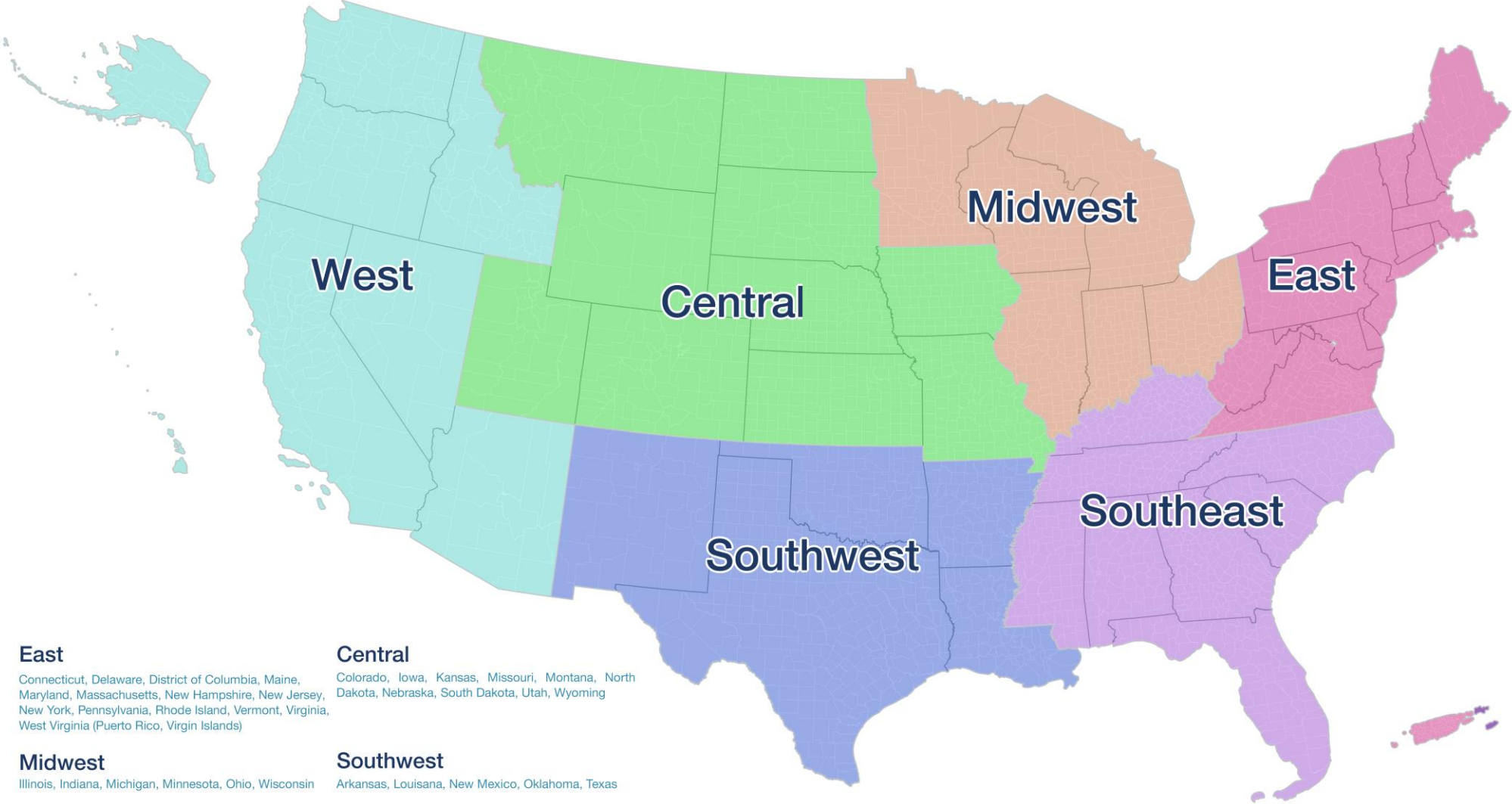


LEADERSHIP GEOGRAPHIC REPRESENTATION
