
Organizational Background

- A regional, non-profit government agency operating under Michigan PA 281 of 1945
- One of the 14 RPOs in Michigan
- Established in 1968
- Covers Chippewa, Luce, and Mackinac Counties
 - Home of the Soo Locks, Tahquamenon Falls, and Mackinac Island
- Assists through grant writing, community surveys, planning, development, transportation, and mapping



Statewide Housing Partnership

- Governor Whitmer signed EO 2022-10 establishing the Statewide Housing Partnership (SHP) as an advisory body.
- The partnership's responsibility is to develop a strategy to implement the MI Statewide Housing Plan.
- The plan presents opportunities to tackle common objectives, including rehabilitating and stabilizing the housing supply, reducing equity gaps and homelessness, and more.
- The SHP established regional consortiums (RHPs) to ensure statewide initiatives build on local efforts whenever possible. - MSHDA



Program Background

- EUP Regional Planning & Development Commission and Chippewa-Luce-Mackinac Community Action Agency co-applied to lead the RHP in our region
- Awarded funding in 2023 via MSHDA
- 2025 and onward, EUP is the lead agency
- Regional Focus: Creating a housing development ecosystem from the ground up
 - Gathering resources and information
 - Locating funding and funders
 - Educating the region
 - Developing housing developers



Awards and the Funding Organization

- RHP 1.0 began June 1, 2023 and ended May 31, 2025
- MSHDA awarded EUP with RHP 1.0 programmatic funding
 - \$175,000
- RHP 2.0 began June 1, 2025 and ends May 31, 2026
- MSHDA awarded EUP with RHP 2.0 programmatic funding
 - \$75,000




Highlights – Emerging Developers Roadshow

Highlights – RHP Action Grant

- Received a RHP Actions Grant through MSHDA, which paid for:
 - Another year of our data dashboard through StateBook
 - The expansion of Chippewa County's Brownfield Redevelopment Authority; it will now cover the entire county
 - Coordinating with Fishbeck to complete this task


