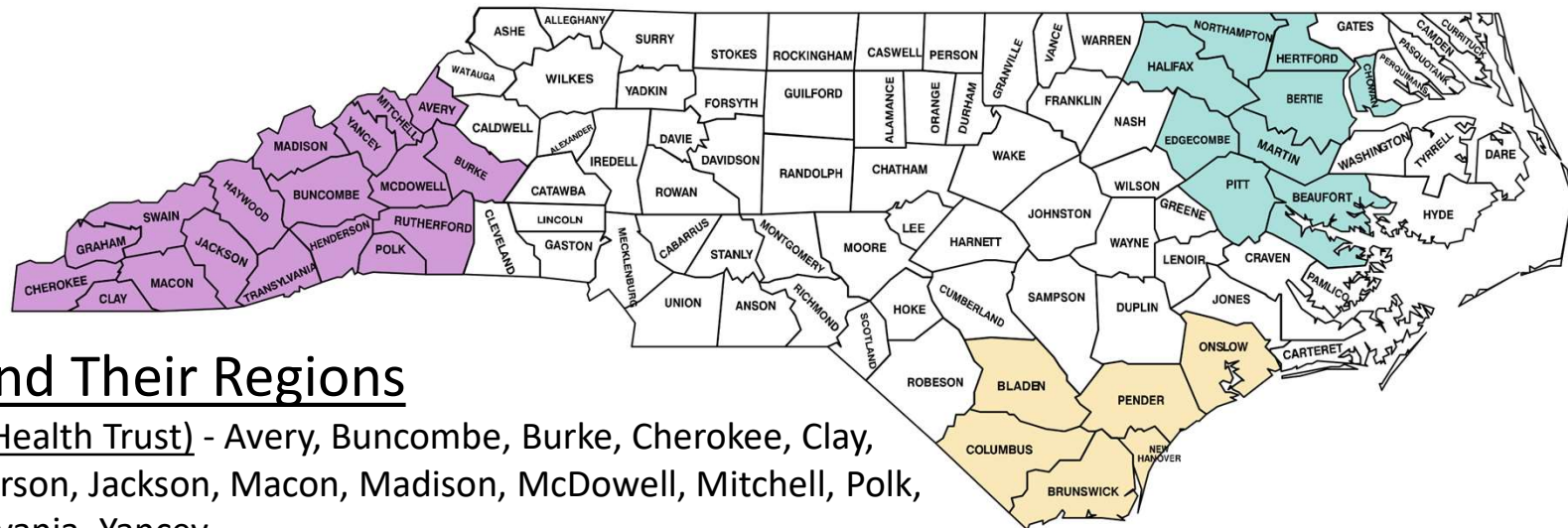

Healthy Opportunities Pilot

The federal government authorized up to \$650 million in state and federal Medicaid funding to provide non-medical services to Medicaid enrollees at higher risk to evaluate the impact on their health outcomes and health care utilization and costs.

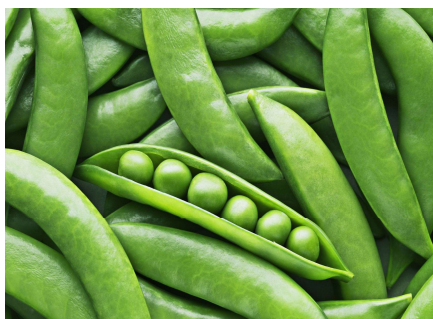

Our Responsibilities

1. Assist Impact Health with building a transportation network throughout the Pilot service area
2. Provide technical assistance to Human Service Organizations (HSO) to access/utilize necessary technology platforms (NCCARE360, NCTracks, etc.)
3. Work with Care Managers/PHPs to ensure appropriate referrals
4. Approve/Revise bills from HSOs
5. Act as pass-through agent for HSOs as necessary

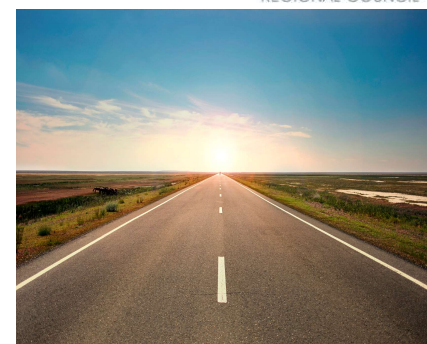


Food
