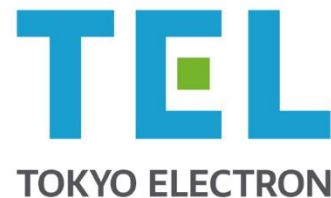

Manufacturing & Workforce Demand

- The U.S. manufacturing industry may need as many as 3.8 million new employees between 2024 and 2033.
 - Of those, about 1.9 million jobs could go unfilled unless workforce & training issues are addressed.
 - This shows there is a big future gap unless systems like K-12 / early credential pathways help feed the pipeline.
- McKinsey & Company reports that due to investment and demand, there could be a shortage of 2.1 million manufacturing workers in the U.S. by 2030.

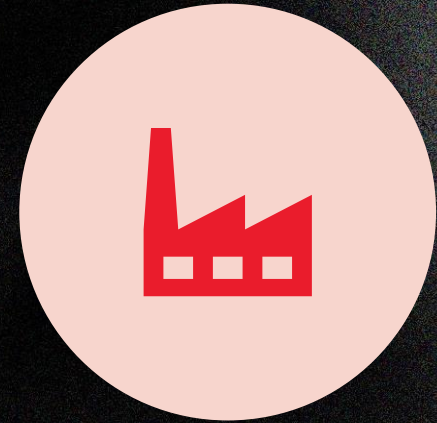
3 Pillars of Workforce Development
